






 Forests worldwide play a major role in supporting the quality of life of people worldwide by providing a broad array of environmental, cultural, social and economic goods and services.


Forest degradation, less obvious but even more widespread, is reducing the capacity of forests to provide the goods and services demanded by the world's growing population.



































Goal 13: Climate action: "Take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts by regulating emissions and promoting developments in renewable energy."

Goal 11: Sustainable cities and communities: "Make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient, and sustainable."










Goal 6: Clean water and sanitation: "Ensure availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for all."




